DIRECTIONS TO RINGWOOD STATE PARK

GPS: 41.138573, -74.230956

From points in Up-State NY: Take I-87 (NY State Thruway) South to Exit 15A (Rte 17 North). Turn right onto Rte 17 North and go approx 2 miles. Bear right onto exit ramp for CR-72 (Sterling Mine Rd). Continue south on Sterling Mine Rd. for approx 3.5 miles. Sterling Mine Rd. becomes Sloatsburg Rd. at the NJ border. Continue on Sloatsburg Rd. for approx 1.5 miles. Turn left at Morris Rd. entrance to Ringwood State Park. Continue on Morris Rd. for 1.3 miles then turn left on Shepherd Pond Rd. following signs to Shepherd's Lake Recreation Area. Bear left once inside the gate and drive up to the parking lot at the top of the hill.

From points in CT and Westchester County via the Tappan Zee Bridge: Continue on I-87 North (NY State Thruway) /287 West for about 17 miles past the Tappan Zee Bridge. When I-287 splits off from I-87, continue on I-87 North toward Albany for about 1.5 miles. Take Exit 15A (Rte 17 North / Rte 59). Turn left onto Rte 17 North and go approx 1.5 miles. Bear right onto exit ramp for CR-72 (Sterling Mine Rd). Continue south on Sterling Mine Rd. for approx 3.5 miles. Sterling Mine Rd. becomes Sloatsburg Rd. at the NJ border. Continue on Sloatsburg Rd. for approx 1.5 miles. Turn left at Morris Rd. entrance to Ringwood State Park. Continue on Morris Rd. for 1.3 miles then turn left on Shepherd Pond Rd. following signs to Shepherd's Lake Recreation Area. Bear left once inside the gate and drive up to the parking lot at the top of the hill.

From NYC and points on LI via George Washington Bridge: From GWB take I-95 South approx 1 mile to Exit 72A (Rte 4 West -Paramus). Continue on Rte 4 West for approx 8.5 miles then bear right onto Rte 208 North. Continue on Rte 208 North for approx 10 miles toward Oakland. Rte 208 then joins I-287 South. Continue on I-287 South about 1 mile to Exit 57 (Skyline Drive -Ringwood). Continue on Skyline Dr to end (about 5 miles). Turn right on Greenwood Lake Tnpke. Go approx 1 mile and then bear right onto Sloatsburg Rd. Go approx 1.5 miles. Turn right at Morris Rd. entrance to Ringwood State Park. Continue on Morris Rd. for 1.3 miles then turn left on Shepherd Pond Rd. following signs to Shepherd's Lake Recreation Area. Bear left once inside the gate and drive up to the parking lot at the top of the hill.

From points in NJ via I-287: From I-287 North take Exit 55 (CR-511 - Wanaque and Pompton Lakes). Turn right onto Ringwood Ave. Proceed on Ringwood Ave for approx 4 miles. Ringwood Ave. then becomes Greenwood Lake Tnpke. Proceed for another 3 miles and then bear right onto Sloatsburg Rd. Go approx 1.5 miles. Turn right at Morris Rd entrance to Ringwood State Park. Continue on Morris Rd. for 1.3 miles then turn left on Shepherd Pond Rd. following signs to Shepherd's Lake Recreation Area. Bear left once inside the gate and drive up to the parking lot at the top of the hill.
